

# Measuring Mount Card

alternative method

Method provided by Alistair Petrie

Standard mount card measuring 500mm x 400mm

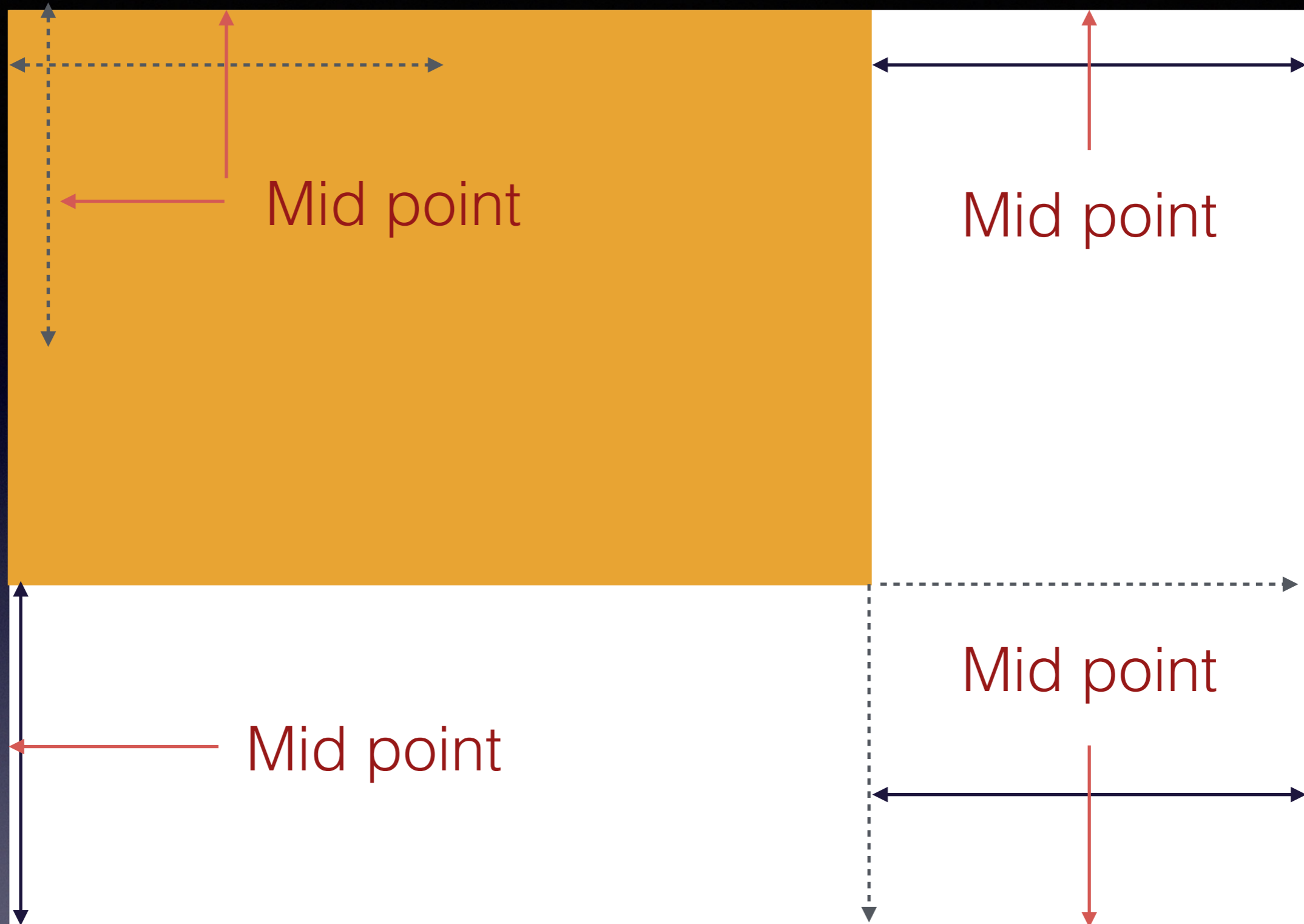


In this presentation the mount card is the white object

# The photo



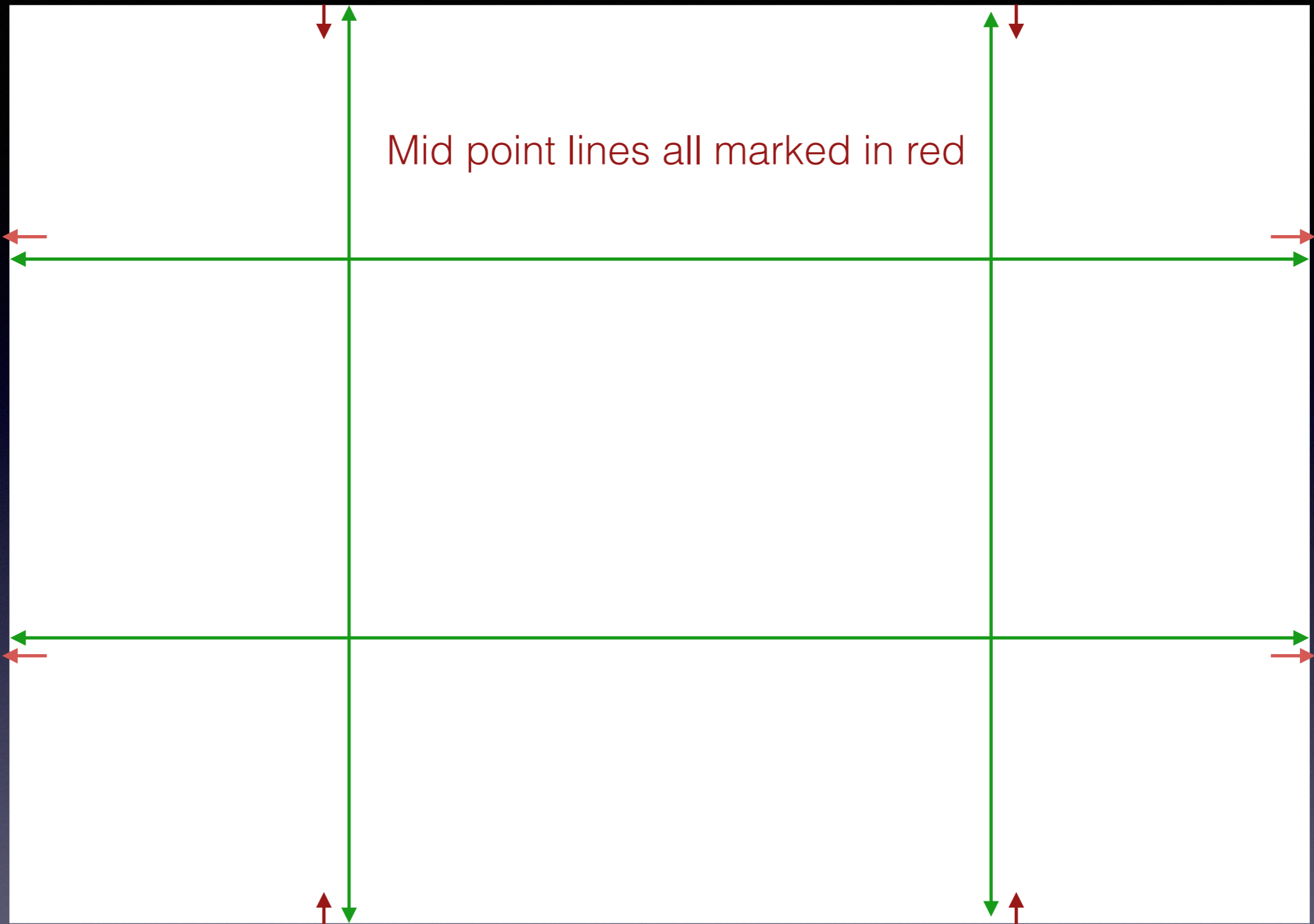
In this presentation the photo is the orange object



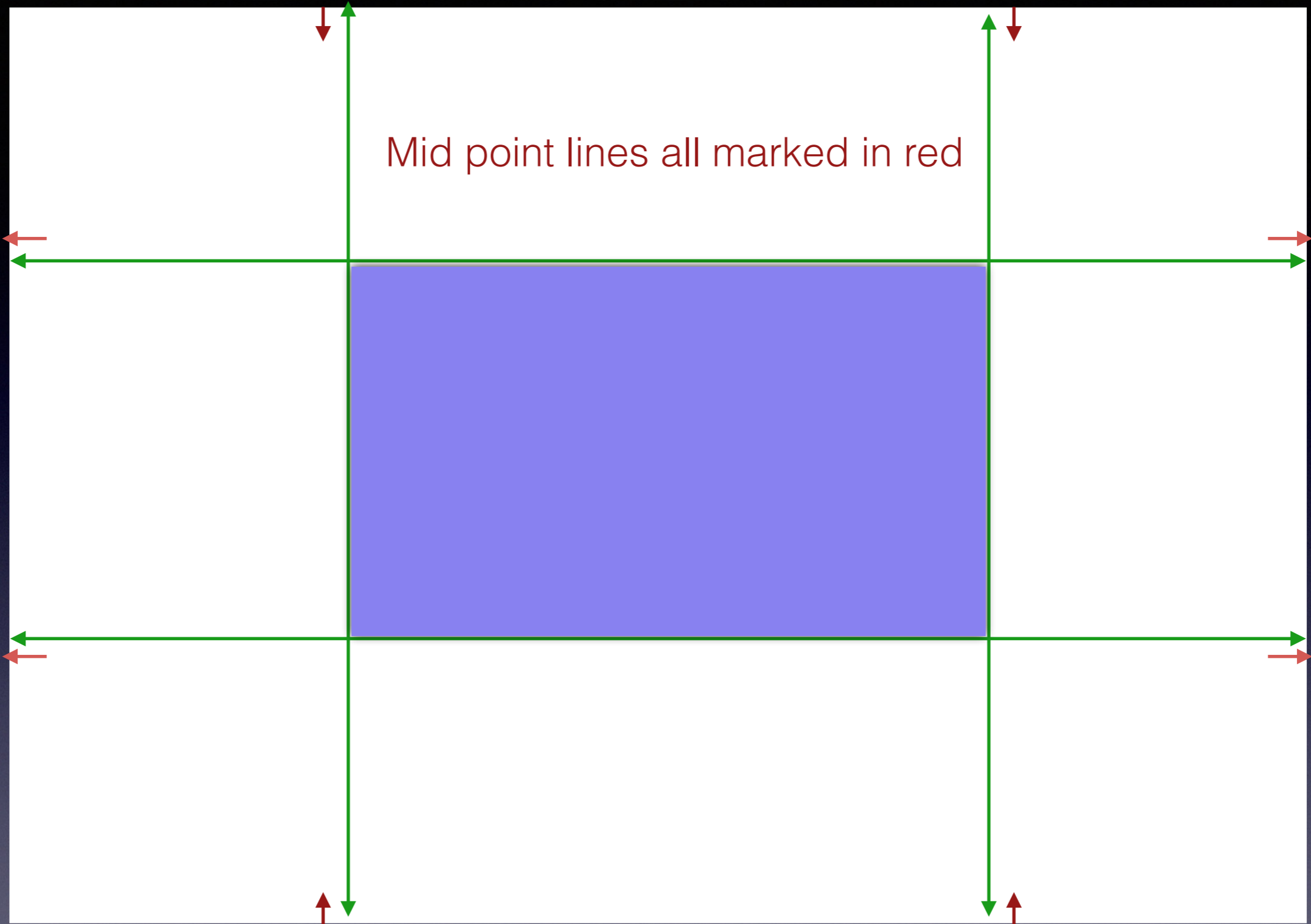
Place the photo on the upper left corner of the mount card and mark the mid point of the 3 areas that the card does not cover. This will also give you the measurement for the forth corner (area covered by the photo)

Mid point lines marked

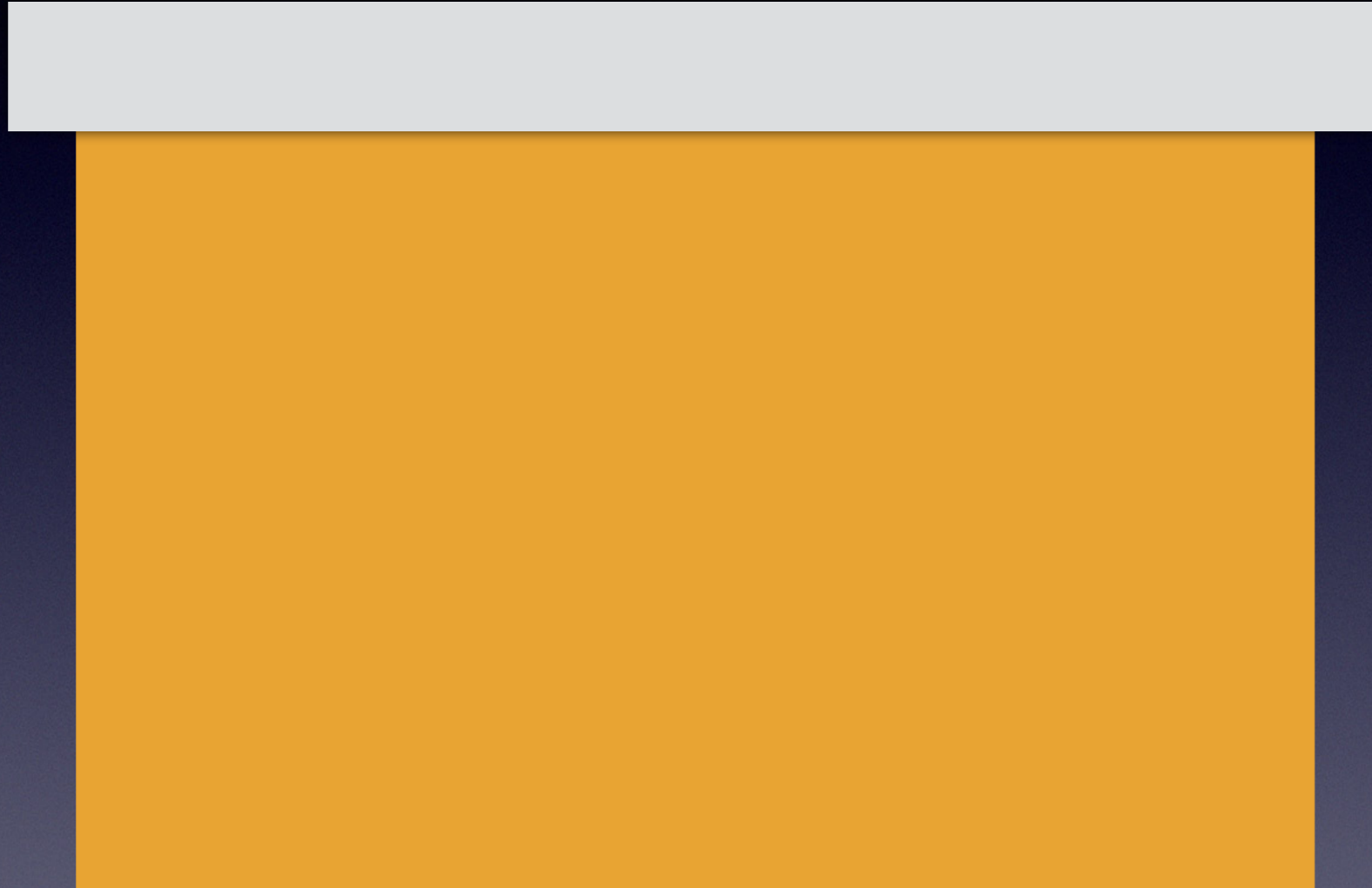




Now measure 5mm inside of each mid point line and join the lines up  
(The new lines are marked with green)

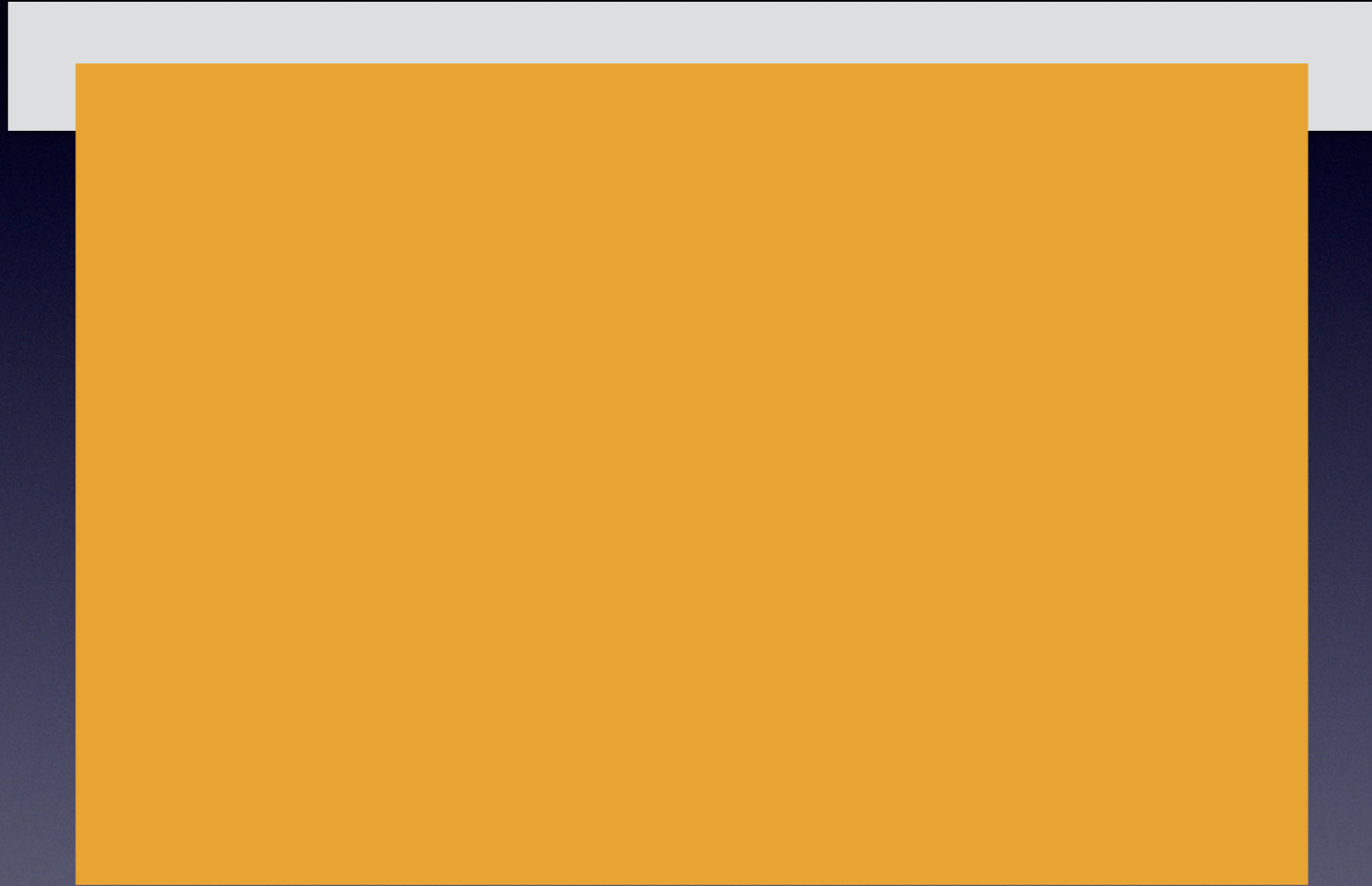


The area marked in purple is the aperture to be cut out using the mount cutter



Place the photo image side away from you and apply a strip of low tack tape to the top edge





Turn the photo over so that the image is now facing you



Lower the mount card over the photo, positioning the image in the aperture as required



Turn the mount board over and apply extra tape as required
